Statement on how the building product is expected to contribute to compliance:

Makita pin nails are intended for use in brad nail guns (manual, electric, pneumatic), and can be used for applying trim, paneling and moulding in indoor projects, as well as for discrete fixing materials such as upholstery, laminate, veneers in furniture manufacturing.

Structural strength (NZBC: B1) and durability (NZBC: B2) of the fixation depends on fastened material's thickness and strength, as well as on hardness of the substrate to which it is fastened.

Makita pin nails are manufactured according to specifications:

- nail length = 24.84mm(F-31838), 34.8mm(F-31854)
- diameter 0.635-0.650 mm
- tensile strength 100-130 kg/mm²
- electroplated coating >0.8 micron

Limitations on the use of the building product:

Not recommended for use in coastal environment with high exposure to moisture and salts.
Do not use pin nails that appear to be damaged, bent, rusty or corroded.
Use nails specified by the brad nailer manufacturer.

Installation should be carried out by a suitably qualified practitioner in accordance with good trade practice

Maintenance requirements (also provide link to the product maintenance guide):

Handle nails and their box carefully. If the nails have been handled roughly, they may be out of shape or their connector breaks, causing poor nail feed.
Avoid storing nails in a very humid or hot place or place exposed to direct sunlight.
