Statement on how the building product is expected to contribute to compliance:

Makita staples are intended for use in staple guns (manual, electric, pneumatic), as well as in hammertackers and can be used for fastening materials such as plastic foil, insulating foil, corrugated cardboard or carpets.
Structural strength (NZBC: B1) and durability (NZBC: B2) of the construction depends on fastened material's thickness and strength, as well as on hardness of the substrate to which it is fastened.

Makita staples are manufactured according to specifications:

- nail length $\pm 0.25\text{mm}$
- outer width max. 10.8mm
- inner width min. 9.2mm
- nail shoulder crown $9.45 \pm 0.1\text{mm}$
- electroplated coating $> 0.8\text{micron}$

Limitations on the use of the building product:

Not recommended for use in coastal environment with high exposure to moisture and salts.

Do not insert staples of which size is different each other at the same time inside the magazine of a staple gun.

Maintenance requirements (also provide link to the product maintenance guide)

Handle the staples and their box carefully. If the staples have been handled roughly, they may be bent out of shape, causing poor staple feed or jamming.

Avoid storing the staples in a very humid or hot place or place exposed to direct sunlight.

If the installed staples exhibit rust they should be replaced before they affect the durability of the material being fastened.
